July 16-20 – KIDS STORYBOOK THEATRE CAMP: Arts Place of Stokes, INSTRUCTORS: Peter & Christina Holland
\$50 Per Student - Students Ages 6-10 – 10:00 am to 12:00 am Daily. [Minimum of 10 students enrolled]
 Students will learn beginning acting techniques, improvisation, staging, and teamwork; all leading up to a week ending recital of "Animal Tales."

July 16-20 – KIDS VISUAL ART CAMP: Mount Olive Elementary School, INSTRUCTOR: Amanda Adams Gordon
\$85 Per Student - Students Ages 6-12 - 9:00 am to 1:00 pm Daily. [Minimum of 10 students enrolled]
 This camp will explore several different genres and styles of art while introducing students to the art elements and design principles. They will paint, draw, create paper sculptures, create art using images from the world around them, as well as work some from their imagination. They will start to understand artists as designers and understand how everyday objects have some artistic influence.
 This camp will also incorporate artistic games during the daily lunch break.

July 16-20 – KIDS POTTERY CAMP: Arts Place of Stokes, INSTRUCTOR: Merideth Van Meter

 This class will focus mostly on beginner and intermediate instruction on the potter's wheel, providing proper technique and allowing the student to complete projects such as cups, bowls, plates, etc. Instruction will also include glazes and firing of pottery.

July 23-27– KIDS NEW PERSPECTIVES ON ART CAMP: Mt. Olive Elementary School,
 INSTRUCTORS: Zach & Stacy McCraw
\$85 Per Student - Students Ages 7-14 - 9:00 am to 1:00 pm Daily.
